**GENERAL ORDER RE: REPEAL OF LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES 8001-1, 8003-1, 8005-1 AND
9037-1 AND LOCAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS 9037-1A AND 9037-1B AND
ADOPTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS 8002-1, 8004-1, 8005-1, 8007-1, AND 9037-1 AND
LOCAL BANKRUPTCY FORM 9037-1**

WHEREAS, by General Orders dated and filed on January 29, 2013, this Court adopted the Local Bankruptcy Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire (hereinafter referred to as the Local Bankruptcy Rules), Administrative Orders of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire (hereinafter referred to as Administrative Orders), and the Local Bankruptcy Forms of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire (hereinafter referred to as Local Bankruptcy Forms); and

WHEREAS, Local Bankruptcy Rule 9029-2 authorizes this Court to adopt administrative orders and forms for the conduct and disposition of proceedings before it and, from time to time, to alter and amend the same, provided that such administrative orders and forms are not inconsistent with the provisions of the United States Bankruptcy Code, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure or Local Bankruptcy Rules; and

WHEREAS, 28 U.S.C. §§ 2071 and 2077, Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 77.4 of the Local Rules of the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire, authorize the Court to repeal Local Bankruptcy Rules where inconsistent with Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; it is hereby

ORDERED that Local Bankruptcy Rules 8001-1, 8003-1, 8005-1, and 9037-1 and Local Bankruptcy Forms 9037-1A and 9037-1B are hereby repealed, as they are inconsistent with changes to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure taking effect on December 1, 2014, and in some respect with new guidance from the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts; and it is further

ORDERED that the attached Administrative Orders 8002-1, 8004-1, 8005-1, 8007-1, and 9037-1 and Local Bankruptcy Form 9037-1 are hereby prescribed and promulgated pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 9029-2 and shall take effect on December 1, 2014, and shall govern all bankruptcy cases and proceedings thereafter commenced and, insofar as is just and practicable, all bankruptcy cases and proceedings then pending in this Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the clerk shall post a copy of this order in the clerk's office and on the Court's web site at www.nhb.uscourts.gov, indicating copies of the same are available upon request.
