WHEREAS Interim Rules 1007, 1020, 2009, 2012, 2015, 3010, 3011, 3014, 3016, 3017.1, 3017.2, 3018, and 3019 have been superseded by amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure that took effect on December 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, 28 U.S.C. §§ 2071 and 2077, Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 77.4 of the Local Rules of the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire, authorize the Court to repeal the Interim Rules; it is hereby

ORDERED that Interim Rules 1007, 1020, 2009, 2012, 2015, 3010, 3011, 3014, 3016, 3017.1, 3017.2, 3018, and 3019 are hereby repealed as being superseded by amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure that took effect on December 1, 2022; and it is further
