Connecting to the Wireless Display

 Ask the Calendar Clerk to select Wireless Display from the touch panel. Alternatively, you can select Wireless Display from the touch panel on the podium.

2. The courtroom screens will display the Wireless Adapter screen.



3. On your laptop, click the Notification icon located on the bottom right of your screen.



4. Click the **Connect** tile (you may need to click **Expand** to show this tile)

- 6. If prompted, enter the PIN displayed on the screens. Your laptop is now displayed wirelessly throughout the courtroom.
