**GENERAL ORDER RE: REPEAL, AMENDMENT, AND ADOPTION OF
LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES, AMENDMENT AND ADOPTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS,
AND AMENDMENT OF LOCAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS**

WHEREAS, by General Orders dated and filed on October 5, 2016, this Court adopted the Local Bankruptcy Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire (hereinafter referred to as the Local Bankruptcy Rules), Administrative Orders of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire (hereinafter referred to as Administrative Orders), and the Local Bankruptcy Forms of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire (hereinafter referred to as Local Bankruptcy Forms); and

WHEREAS, in compliance with 28 U.S.C. § 2071(b), the court has given the public appropriate notice and an opportunity for comment upon the proposed revisions to the Local Bankruptcy Rules; and

WHEREAS, Local Bankruptcy Rule 9029-2 authorizes this Court to adopt administrative orders and forms for the conduct and disposition of proceedings before it and, from time to time, to alter and amend the same, provided that such administrative orders and forms are not inconsistent with the provisions of the United States Bankruptcy Code, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure or Local Bankruptcy Rules; and

WHEREAS, 28 U.S.C. §§ 2071 and 2077, Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 77.4 of the Local Rules of the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire, authorize the Court to repeal Local Bankruptcy Rules where inconsistent with Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; it is hereby

ORDERED that Administrative Order 5001-2 and Local Bankruptcy Forms 1009-1B, 2016-2, 3007-1, 3012-1A, 3012-1B, 3015-1B, 3015-1C, 3017-1A, 3017-1B, 3020-1, 4001-2, 4001-4B, 4003-2B, 4003-2C, 7055-1, 9021-1A, 9021-1B, 9021-1C, 9037-1, and 9072-1 shall be amended, in the form attached, to reflect the Court's new address in Concord, New Hampshire and shall take effect on November 20, 2017, and shall govern all bankruptcy cases and proceedings thereafter commenced and, insofar as is just and practicable, all bankruptcy cases and proceedings then pending in this Court; and it is further

ORDERED that Local Bankruptcy Rule 1006-1 is repealed and replaced by the attached Administrative Order 1006-1, that the attached Local Bankruptcy Rule 3001-2 is adopted, that Local Bankruptcy Rule 3015-1(b) is amended, in the form attached, and that Local Bankruptcy Forms 1009-1B, 3015-1A, and 3015-1B are amended, in the form attached, and shall take effect on December 1, 2017, and shall govern all bankruptcy cases and proceedings thereafter commenced and, insofar as is just and practicable, all bankruptcy cases and proceedings then pending in this Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the clerk shall post a copy of this order in the clerk's office and on the Court's website at www.nhb.uscourts.gov, indicating copies of the same are available upon request.
