1. What hardware/software is required on the attorneys' end to use CM/ECF?

Answer: Attorneys will need the following hardware and software to electronically file, view and retrieve documents in the electronic filing system:

- A personal computer running a standard platform such as Windows 95, 98, 2000, NT, XP or Macintosh which has 65MB of RAM or better.
- Access to the Internet. If you are using a modem to connect to your Internet service provided, we recommend one with a speed of at least 56k.
- Netscape Navigator version 4.6x or 4.7x or Internet Explorer 5.x or higher. **DO NOT USE** America On Line's browser.
- Adobe Acrobat software to convert documents from a word processor format to portable document format (PDF). Adobe Acrobat 4.0 and 5.0 adequately meet the CM/ECF filing requirements. Versions of WordPerfect greater than 9 have PDF software exchanges built into their programs, however the Adobe software creates the cleanest conversions with the smallest file size.
- A word processing application such as Windows-based versions of WordPerfect and Word.
- A scanner to image document that are not in your word processing system.
- An e-mail application and a valid e-mail account. (5/15/03)

2. Do I need any specific computer skills?

Answer: You should be familiar with the following:

- Using the forward and back buttons on an Internet Browser
- Attach a file within a web browser
- Read a document in PDF using Adobe Acrobat
- Convert a word processing document into PDF
- Download files
- Using hyper links (5/15/03)

3. What is Adobe Acrobat?

Answer: Adobe Acrobat is commercial software which allows you to convert your documents to PDF (portable document format). All documents filed in CM/ECF must be in PDF. (5/15/03)

4. What Windows based petition preparation software should I use?

Answer: The court does not recommend or endorse any particular software vendor. Listed below are a number of vendors who have modified their software to allow for automatic case upload from their application into CM/ECF.
