The U.S. Bankruptcy Court and the Clerk's Office for the District of New Hampshire is currently scheduled to move from its present location to 1000 Elm Street, Manchester, NH 03101 on **Friday, June 4, 2004**. The Court will be located at 1000 Elm Street for a period of three to five years. Telephone numbers, excluding fax numbers, will remain the same.

The Court and Clerk's Office will be closed for all business on Friday, June 4, 2004. We will reopen on Monday, June 7, 2004, at 1000 Elm Street.

The Clerk's Office will be located on the 10th Floor, while both courtrooms will be located on the 11th Floor. The courtroom assigned to Chief Judge Vaughn will be designated as Courtroom 1. The courtroom assigned to Judge Deasy will be designated as Courtroom 2. For any hearing scheduled on or after June 7, 2004, the Notice of Hearing should list 1000 Elm Street, 11th Floor and the appropriate courtroom number as the hearing location.

Section 341 Creditor Meetings scheduled after June 4, 2004 will be held at 1000 Elm Street, 7th Floor, Room 702.
