SUBJECT: Proposed Amendments and Additions to Local Bankruptcy Rules, Administrative Orders,

and Forms and Repeal of Interim Bankruptcy Rules

DATE: October 31, 2008

On December 1, 2008, the Court will repeal the Interim Bankruptcy Rules, with the exception of IBR 5012, as amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure that take effect on December 1, 2008, will supersede the Interim Bankruptcy Rules.

Effective January 1, 2009, the Court intends to amend Local Bankruptcy Rules 3015-1, 3015-3, and 3015-4 related to chapter 13 plans, to revise Local Bankruptcy Form 3015-1A regarding chapter 13 plans, and to revise Local Bankruptcy Form 3015-1B and adopt Local Bankruptcy Form 3015-1C to provide new notice in chapter 13 cases. In addition, the Court intends to adopt Administrative Order 1007-8 regarding automatic dismissal of cases where required documents are not timely filed, and Administrative Order 4001-1, which will require most motions for relief to have a worksheet attached to it in the form of either Local Bankruptcy Form 4001-1C or Local Bankruptcy Form 4001-1D.

A thirty-day public comment period on these proposed changes will commence on October 31, 2008, and on end on November 30, 2008. Drafts of these rules, administrative orders, and forms are available for review on the Court's website at www.nhb.uscourts.gov. In addition, a paper copy is available for review at the Clerk's Office.
