The Clerk's Office plans to start scanning all checks received as payment. Those payments will then be submitted electronically to the U.S. Treasury. After these transactions have cleared the bank, the checks will be destroyed.

Customers who provide a check as payment authorize us either (1) to use information from their check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from their account or (2) to process the payment as a check transaction.

A Privacy Act Statement required by 5 U.S.C. § 552a(e)(3) stating our authority for soliciting and collecting the information from customers' checks, and explaining the purposes and routine uses which will be made of customers' check information, is available from the U.S. Treasury internet site at http://www.fms.treas.gov/otcnet/index.html, or customers can call toll free at 1-866-945-7920 to obtain a copy by mail. Furnishing the check information is voluntary, but a decision not to do so may require customers to make payment by some other method.
